- 7:30am** Arrive at school in full uniform and report to the JH Band Room. Take instrument out of case and put case back in band locker. Please make arrangements to be at school on time!
- 7:40am Attendance taken, and we will walk over to the JCA together. Cases remain in the JH Band Room.
- 7:55am Warm-up begins for 7th Grade in the JCA.
- **8:25am Jenison 7th Grade Band Performs on the stage of the JCA.****
- 8:50am 7th Grade Band will move to the JCA Black Box where they will perform in Sight-Reading.
- 9:25am 7th Grade Band will finish Sight-Reading and return to the JCA Auditorium to listen to the the Allendale 7th Grade Band.
- 9:50am Students will walk back to the Jr. High Band Room where they will put instruments away. Brass and Percussion report to second hour to get any homework or assignments. Woodwind/Hn report to the band rm.
- 10:00am Students will resume their normal school day. Brass/Perc have a sub during 5th hour band; bring pencil and homework to do!

- Bring all of your music. **Do not rely on your stand partner to bring it for you!**
