- 12:44pm Students will report to their normal 5th hour band period. Students will either complete a study hall or see their 3rd/4th hour teacher if requested by their teacher. 6th hour will be normal for students!

- Bring all of your music. **Do not rely on your stand partner to bring it for you!**
